The Role: Instrumentation Tuber

This is a full time position on the day shift in our Burlington/Oakville location:

Monday - Friday: 7:00AM - 3:30PM, with occasional overtime

Responsibilities:

The position will involve the following tasks:

- Select tubing size, fittings and wall thickness according to project specifications.
- Repair and adjust system components, such as sensors, transmitters and control valves, or remove and replace defective parts.
- Install control and measurement instruments on existing and new plant equipment and processes.
- Responsible for bending and installing tubing following the P&IDs as a guide. Mounting components as required for each individual line.
- Ensuring the tubing is the correct wall thickness
- Ensure the swage is completed as per manufactures specifications.
- Ensure the tubing has been deburred and use an airline to blow debris from the line.



- Some familiarity with Piping and Instrumentation Diagrams. These are typically interpreted (2D) and turned into 3D tubing systems.

Requirements:

- 1-2 years of directly related work experience.

High school diploma; successful completion of an apprenticeship is a plus.
